The study on the need analysis of OSH for aged workforce in manufacturing industries in Malaysia was initiated based on the current trend of aged workforce in Malaysia. Based on the data from the Department of Statistics on Malaysia's population projections (revised) for 2010-2040, Malaysia is expected to start experience the population aged in 2020, when the percentage of the population aged 65 years and over reaches 7.2 per cent.
